# Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Golf Course License

### Ho. Co. 5-99

FOR the purpose of creating in Howard County a Class GC (golf course) beer and light wine license; establishing a certain fee for the license established by this Act; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages at golf courses in Howard County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

#### 8-504.

- (a) This section applies only in Howard County.
- (b) In this section, "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners.
- (c) The Board may issue A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE OR A 7-day Class GC (golf course) beer, wine and liquor [licenses] LICENSE.
- (d) A license may be issued on behalf of an organization that owns or manages a golf course with a minimum of 18 holes.
  - (e) The annual license fee is:
- (1) \$350 FOR A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE; AND
- (2) \$1,500 FOR A 7-DAY CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- (f) The license is for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises.
- (g) The hours and days for sale are found in § 11–514 of this article. However, the Board may reduce the hours and days for sale for all or a portion of the licensed premises.
