SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Insurance

15-829.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "CHLAMYDIA SCREENING TEST" MEANS ANY LABORATORY TEST THAT:
- SPECIFICALLY DETECTS. FOR INFECTION BY ONE OR MORE (I) AGENTS OF CHLAMYDIA TRACHOMATIS; AND
- (II) IS APPROVED FOR THIS PURPOSE BY THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION.
- (3) "MULTIPLE RISK FACTORS" MEANS HAVING A PRIOR HISTORY OF A SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE, NEW OR MULTIPLE SEX PARTNERS, INCONSISTENT USE OF BARRIER CONTRACEPTIVES, OR CERVICAL ECTOPY.
 - (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND
- HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE HOSPITAL. MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.
- (C) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR AN ANNUAL ROUTINE CHLAMYDIA SCREENING TEST FOR:
 - **(1)** WOMEN WHO ARE:
- UNDER THE AGE OF 20 YEARS IF THEY ARE SEXUALLY ACTIVE: AND
- (II) AT LEAST 20 YEARS OLD IF THEY HAVE MULTIPLE RISK FACTORS; AND
 - MEN WHO HAVE MULTIPLE RISK FACTORS. (2)
- SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COVERAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE SUBJECT TO A CO-PAYMENT OR COINSURANCE REQUIREMENT OR DEDUCTIBLE THAT AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION IMPOSES FOR SIMILAR COVERAGES UNDER THE SAME POLICY OR CONTRACT.
