- (1) For the purpose of reducing funds available for regular positions and associated fringe benefits by one-quarter of one percent, funds appropriated in this budget for turnover expectancy (subobject 0189) shall be reduced as provided in this section;
- (2) The Governor shall develop a schedule for allocating this reduction to the programs of the executive branch and take such actions as may be required to implement the reduction under Section 7-213 of the State Finance and Procurement Article;
- (3) It is the intent of the General Assembly that agencies with appropriations reduced through amendment elsewhere in this act for the purpose of increasing turnover expectancy for positions other than new positions be held harmless from the provisions of this section; and
- (4) Aggregate reductions under this section shall equal at least the amounts indicated for the budgetary fund types listed:

SECTION 32. 43. 44. 45. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That numerals of this bill showing subtotals and totals are informative only and are not actual appropriations. The actual appropriations are in the numerals for individual items of appropriation. It is the legislative intent that in subsequent printings of the bill the numerals in subtotals and totals shall be administratively corrected or adjusted for continuing purposes of information, in order to be in arithmetic accord with the numerals in the individual items.
