Such a plan must include measurable outcomes and appropriate accountability measures aligned with early childhood education programs; and strategies to meet the needs of working families by providing a collaborative program of child care and Head Start Services.

Further provided that the subcabinet shall submit a report to the budget committees detailing all State spending on Head Start by December 1, 2000.
