- (b) In setting the amount of a civil money penalty under this section, the Secretary shall consider, pursuant to guidelines set forth in regulations promulgated by the Secretary, the following factors:
 - (1) The number, nature, and seriousness of the deficiencies;
- (2) The degree of risk to the health, life, or safety of the residents of the nursing [facility] HOME caused by the deficiency or deficiencies;
- (3) The efforts made by the nursing [facility] HOME to correct the deficiency or deficiencies;
- (4) Whether the amount of the proposed civil money penalty will jeopardize the financial ability of the nursing [facility] HOME to continue operating as a nursing [facility] HOME; and
 - (5) Such other factors as justice may require.

19-1406.

- (a) The nursing [facility] HOME shall provide written notice to the Department when the deficiency or deficiencies identified in the notice issued pursuant to § 19-1404 are substantially corrected.
- (b) The calculation of the amount of the civil money penalty will stop as of the date the notice in subsection (a) of this section is received by the Department.
- (c) The Department shall schedule and conduct a reinspection of the nursing [facility] HOME within 24 hours of its receipt of the notice pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.
- (d) If, following the reinspection, the Department determines that the deficiency or deficiencies have not been substantially corrected, the [facility's] HOME'S notice under subsection (a) of this section shall be invalid and the civil money penalty imposed under § 19-1405(a) shall remain in effect.

19-1407.

- (a) The nursing [facility] HOME shall have the right to appeal from the order within 30 days from the receipt of the order.
- (b) The appeal shall be heard by the Hearings Office of the Department, which shall render the final agency decision for purposes of judicial review.
- (c) Imposition of the civil money penalty shall be stayed until the final decision is issued pursuant to subsection (m) of this section.
- (d) A hearing on the appeal shall be held within 10 working days of the request for hearing.
- (e) The parties to the hearing shall be the aggrieved nursing [facility] HOME and the Secretary.
 - (f) The parties are entitled to be represented by counsel.
