THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSION MAY ORDER AN OFFSET OR CREDIT AGAINST AN AWARD FOR PERMANENT PARTIAL DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR:

- (1) ANY VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION BENEFITS PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED TO A COVERED EMPLOYEE ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 1999; OR
- (2) ANY TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS PREVIOUSLY PAID TO A COVERED EMPLOYEE ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 1999.

CHAPTER 231

(Senate Bill 117)

AN ACT concerning

Workers' Compensation - Benefits for Permanent Partial Disability - Repeal of Sunset Provision for Benefit Payments for Certain Scheduled Members

FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date for certain changes to the workers' compensation benefit structure for permanent partial disability that exempt the loss of the thumb, fingers, and great toe from the lower tier of benefits and require the payment of benefits for the loss of the thumb, fingers, and great toe at the middle tier of benefits.
