## (XXII) ONE SHALL BE A LICENSED PHARMACIST;

(XXIII) ONE SHALL BE A LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER:

 $\frac{(XXI)}{(XXIV)}$  ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND; AND

 $\frac{(XXII)}{(XXV)}$  ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND HOUSE OF DELEGATES.

- (C) (1) THE TERM OF A VOTING MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (D) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN FOR A 2-YEAR TERM.

4-3A-04.

- (A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE ADVISORY COUNCIL IS A QUORUM.
- (B) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.
  - (C) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:
    - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
