

(XXII) ONE SHALL BE A LICENSED PHARMACIST;

(XXIII) ONE SHALL BE A LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER;

~~(XXI)~~ (XXIV) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND; AND

~~(XXII)~~ (XXV) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND HOUSE OF DELEGATES.

(C) (1) THE TERM OF A VOTING MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(D) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

4-3A-03.

FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN FOR A 2-YEAR TERM.

4-3A-04.

(A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE ADVISORY COUNCIL IS A QUORUM.

(B) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(C) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL DESIGNATE THE STAFF NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

(A) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL:

(1) ADVISE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF EMERGING ISSUES IN THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF MEDICAL RECORDS;

(2) CONDUCT HEARINGS;
