- (4) "Adjunct claims documentation" means an abstract of an enrollee's medical record which describes and summarizes the diagnosis and treatment of, and services rendered to, the enrollee.
- (b) (1) In addition to any other provisions of this subtitle, for a covered service rendered to an enrollee of a health maintenance organization by a health care provider not under written contract with the health maintenance organization, the health maintenance organization or its agent:
- (i) Shall pay the health care provider within 30 days after the receipt of a claim in accordance with the applicable provisions of this subtitle; and
 - (ii) Shall pay the claim submitted by:
- 1. A hospital at the rate approved by the Health Services Cost Review Commission; and
- 2. Any other health care provider at the rate billed or at the usual, customary, and reasonable rate THE GREATER OF:
- A. 125% OF THE RATE THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION PAYS IN THE SAME GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FOR THE SAME COVERED SERVICE, TO A SIMILARLY LICENSED PROVIDER UNDER WRITTEN CONTRACT WITH THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION; OR
- B. THE RATE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2000 THAT THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION PAID IN THE SAME GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FOR THE SAME COVERED SERVICE, TO A SIMILARLY LICENSED PROVIDER NOT UNDER WRITTEN CONTRACT WITH THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION.
- (2) A-health maintenance organization that pays a health care provider at the usual, customary, and reasonable rate:
- (i) Except for services rendered to medical assistance recipients or for services rendered under a contract entered into under § 1876(g) of the federal Social Security Act (42-U.S.C. § 1395mm), may not use Medicare, Medicaid, or workers' compensation payments as part of any methodology used to determine a payment at the usual, customary, and reasonable rate; [and]
- (II) SHALL BEAR THE BURDEN OF PROVING THAT ITS PAYMENT IS AT THE USUAL, CUSTOMARY, AND REASONABLE RATE; AND

[(ii)](III) On request of the health care provider, shall disclose the methodology used to determine the amount of payment.

(2) A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION SHALL DISCLOSE, ON REQUEST OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER NOT UNDER WRITTEN CONTRACT WITH THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION, THE REIMBURSEMENT RATE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(11)2 OF THIS SUBSECTION.
