than market price from a person who has a power dredge [license] PERMIT under this section to be transplanted for restoration purposes to the oyster sanctuary described in regulations in accordance with paragraph (3) of this subsection.

- (5) The Department shall adopt regulations reserving areas on a rotational basis for restoration and harvesting purposes.
- (6) The Department shall adopt regulations establishing an appropriate penalty to be assessed against a person convicted of taking oysters from a sanctuary or reserved area.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and 8 months, and at the end of May 31, 2004, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

## Health Insurance - Notice of <u>Potential</u> Health Care Providers <u>on Carrier's</u> Provider Panel on Carrier's Provider Panel

FOR the purpose of altering the procedures by which requiring a carrier may satisfy the requirement to make certain information about health care providers available to enrollees and prospective enrollees a list of health care providers on the carrier's provider panel in a certain manner; altering the timing of when the list of providers on the carrier's provider panel must be provided certain information must be made available and must be updated; altering certain information on providers that carriers must provide altering a certain definition; and generally relating to a carrier notifying providing information to enrollees and prospective enrollees of potential health care providers regarding the carrier's provider panel on carriers' provider panels under health insurance.
