- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (h) Staff support for the Commission shall be provided by the Department.
- (i) On OR BEFORE September 30, 2000, the Commission shall submit a report on the results of its investigation and study, together with any resulting policy recommendations, to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly.
- (J) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 2001, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT UPDATING THE RESULTS OF ITS INVESTIGATION AND STUDY, TOGETHER WITH ANY RESULTING POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS, TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO \S 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
