 - (iv) PRESIDENTS' DAY;
- (V) The Friday before Easter and from then through the Monday after Easter;

[(v)](VI) Memorial Day; and

[(vi)] (VII) Primary and general election days.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
