(e) A scholarship awarded under this section:

(1) May be used for the tuition and mandatory fees at any eligible institution; and

(2) May not [exceed]:

(I) EXCEED the equivalent annual tuition and mandatory fees of a resident undergraduate student at the University of Maryland, College Park; AND

(II) BE LESS THAN THE LESSER OF:

1. \$3,000; OR

2. THE EQUIVALENT ANNUAL TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES OF A RESIDENT OF THE INSTITUTION ATTENDED BY THE RECIPIENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP.

CHAPTER 328

(House Bill 37)

AN ACT concerning

Social Security Numbers on Identification Cards - Prohibitions

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a local government from printing or having printed a local government employee's Social Security number on any type of identification card; prohibiting public institutions of higher education from printing or having printed an employee's or a student's Social Security number on any type of identification card; prohibiting public schools from printing or having printed a student's Social Security number on any type of identification card; prohibiting certain public education employers from printing or having printed the Social Security number of certain employees on any type of identification card; prohibiting the State from printing or having printed a State employee's Social Security number on any type of identification card;
