SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- (e) "Crime of violence" means:
 - (1) Abduction;
 - (2) Arson in the first degree;
 - (3) Assault in the first or second degree;
 - (4) Burglary in the first, second, or third degree;
 - (5) Carjacking and armed carjacking;
 - (6) Escape in the first degree;
 - (7) Kidnapping;
 - (8) Voluntary manslaughter;
 - (9) Maiming:
 - (10) Mayhem as previously proscribed under former § 384 of this article;
 - (11) Murder in the first or second degree;
 - (12) Rape in the first or second degree;
 - (13) Robbery;
 - (14) Robbery with a dangerous or deadly weapon;
 - (15) Sexual offense in the first, second, or third degree;
 - (16) An attempt to commit any of the aforesaid offenses; or
