

carjacking or armed carjacking; sexual offense in the first degree; sexual offense in the second degree; use of a handgun in the commission of a felony or other crime of violence; an attempt to commit any of the aforesaid offenses; assault in the first degree; and assault with intent to murder, assault with intent to rape, assault with intent to rob, assault with intent to commit a sexual offense in the first degree, and assault with intent to commit a sexual offense in the second degree, as these crimes were previously proscribed under former § 12 of this article.

The term "correctional institution" includes Patuxent Institution and a local or regional jail or detention center.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

(House Bill 196)

AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Property Tax Exemption Credit - Pocomoke City Chamber of Commerce

FOR the purpose of ~~providing an exemption from property tax for the Pocomoke City Chamber of Commerce; and providing for the application of this Act authorizing the governing body of Worcester County or of a municipal corporation in Worcester County to grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on property that is owned by a certain organization; authorizing Worcester County or a municipal corporation in Worcester County to provide, by law, for certain provisions relating to the property tax credit; and generally relating to property tax credits in Worcester County.~~
