AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance - Preauthorized Health Care Services - Denials of Reimbursement by Carriers

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain health insurance carriers from denying reimbursement to a health care provider for preauthorized or approved services delivered to a patient if a course of treatment health care service has been preauthorized or approved for the patient; providing certain exceptions; providing that a carrier must pay certain claims in accordance with certain provisions of law; defining a certain term; making a stylistic change; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to denials of reimbursement by carriers for preauthorized or approved services delivered to a patient.
