- (5) To use informational and community resources, as these procedures are related to personal, social, emotional, educational, and vocational development and adjustment.
- (h) "FUND" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS, ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELORS, CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS, AND CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS AND THERAPISTS FUND.
- (I) "Marriage and family therapy" means applying marriage and family systems theory, principles, methods, therapeutic techniques, and research in:
- (1) Resolving emotional conflict and modifying perception and behavior in the context of marriage and family life; and
- (2) The identification and assessment of client needs and the implementation of therapeutic intervention.
- [(i)] (J) (1) "Certified supervised counselor-alcohol and drug" means an individual who is certified by the Board to practice alcohol and drug counseling in the State pursuant to the limitations in § 17-302.4 of this title.
- (2) "Certified associate counselor-alcohol and drug" means an individual who is certified by the Board to practice alcohol and drug counseling in the State pursuant to the limitations in § 17-302.5 of this title.
- (3) "Certified professional counselor-alcohol and drug" means an individual who is certified by the Board to practice alcohol and drug counseling in the State.
- [(j)] (K) "Certified professional counselor-marriage and family therapist" means an individual who is certified by the Board to practice marriage and family therapy in the State.
- [(k)](L) "Practice alcohol and drug counseling" means to engage professionally and for compensation in alcohol and drug counseling activities while representing oneself to be a certified professional counselor-alcohol and drug, a certified supervised counselor-alcohol and drug, or a certified associate counselor-alcohol and drug.
- [(1)] (M) "Practice marriage and family therapy" means to engage professionally and for compensation in marriage and family therapy activities while representing oneself to be a certified professional counselor-marriage and family therapist.
- [(m)] (N) "Practice professional counseling" means to engage professionally and for compensation in counseling and appraisal activities while representing oneself to be a professional counselor.
