- (ii) The American Physical Therapy Association; or
- (iii) The Commission on Accreditation of Physical Therapy Education; and
- ${\bf (2)} \quad {\bf Completed\ satisfactorily\ the\ clinical\ training\ required\ by\ the\ physical\ therapy\ curriculum.}$
- (b) If an applicant for a physical therapy license has been educated in physical therapy outside of any state, the applicant shall have:
- (1) Earned all credits at an institution of higher learning that has educational requirements equivalent to a bachelor's degree in physical therapy from a United States program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Physical Therapy Education;
 - (2) Earned a minimum of 120 credit hours in the following manner:
- (i) 50 credit hours in general education to include at least one course in:
 - 1. Humanities;
 - 2. Social science;
 - Behavioral science:
 - Physics with a laboratory;
 - Chemistry with a laboratory;
 - 6. Biology with a laboratory; and
 - 7. Mathematics:
- (ii) 60 credit hours in a professional physical therapy program to include at least one course in:
 - 1. Human anatomy;
 - 2. Human physiology;
 - Neurology;
 - Physiology;
 - 5. Functional anatomy;
 - 6. Kinesiology;
 - 7. Orthopedics;
 - Pediatrics;
 - Geriatrics:
 - 10. Physical agents:
