

(1) A vehicle transferred to [a]:

(I) A spouse, son, daughter, grandchild, parent, sister, brother, grandparent, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, or daughter-in-law of the transferor, and no money or other valuable consideration is involved in the transfer; OR

(II) A NIECE OR NEPHEW OF THE TRANSFEROR IF:

1. THE TRANSFEROR IS AT LEAST 65 YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME OF THE TRANSFER; AND

2. NO MONEY OR OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION IS INVOLVED IN THE TRANSFER;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

CHAPTER 389

(House Bill 566)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Possession and Consumption of Alcohol - Regulation

FOR the purpose of altering provisions of law authorizing certain counties to regulate the possession and consumption of alcohol under certain circumstances to include Charles County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

19-103.

(a) The subdivisions enumerated in this subsection may adopt ordinances or resolutions supplementing this subheading. This includes the authority to regulate possession or consumption of any alcoholic beverage on any public property, property used by the public in general, or on any highway:

(1) Anne Arundel County;
