4-510.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, by proceeding under this subtitle, a petitioner, including a petitioner who acts on behalf of a child or vulnerable adult, is not limited to or precluded from pursuing any other legal remedy.

(b) [An individual who is eligible to petition for relief under] A PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF, AS DEFINED IN § 4-501 OF THIS [SUBTITLE] SUBTITLE, ~~may not petition~~ IS NOT ELIGIBLE for PEACE ORDER relief under Title 3, SUBTITLE 8 OR Subtitle 15 of the Courts Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.
