SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

10-101.

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (B) ."ACOTE" MEANS THE ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY EDUCATION.
 - (C) "AIDE" MEANS ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- (1) IS NOT LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PERFORM OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY OR LIMITED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY; AND
- (2) PROVIDES SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST OR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION.
 - [(b)](D) "Board" means the State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice.
- (E) "DIRECT SUPERVISION" MEANS SUPERVISION PROVIDED ON A FACE-TO-FACE BASIS BY A SUPERVISING THERAPIST WHEN DELEGATED CLIENT-RELATED TASKS ARE PERFORMED.
- [(c)] (F) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice:
 - (1) Occupational therapy; or
 - (2) Limited occupational therapy.
- [(d)](G) "Licensed occupational therapist" means, unless the context requires otherwise, an occupational therapist who is licensed by the Board to practice occupational therapy.
- [(e)] (H) "Licensed occupational therapy assistant" means, unless the context requires otherwise, an occupational therapy assistant who is licensed by the Board to practice limited occupational therapy.
