- (2) [The] COMPLETED THE equivalent of at least 6 months of supervised, full-time field work experience at a recognized educational institution or in a training program approved by the educational institution where the applicant met the academic requirements.
- (e) An applicant for an occupational therapy assistant license shall have [completed] successfully:
- (1) [The academic requirements of] GRADUATED FROM an educational program for occupational therapy assistants that is recognized by the Board and accredited by [the American Occupational Therapy Association] ACOTE or ANY other nationally recognized programmatic accrediting agency; and
- (2) [The]COMPLETED THE equivalent of at least [2] 4 months of supervised, full-time field work experience at a recognized educational institution or in a training program approved by the educational institution where the applicant met the academic requirements.
- (f) [Except as otherwise provided in this title, the] THE applicant shall pass [an] THE APPROPRIATE examination given by [the Board under this subtitle] NBCOT OR ANY OTHER NATIONAL CREDENTIALING ORGANIZATION.

 - (a) To apply for a license, an applicant shall:
- (1) Submit an application to the Board [on] IN the form [that] REQUIRED BY the Board [requires]; and
- (2) Pay to the Board the application fee set by the Board. 10-308.
- (A) The Board shall issue the appropriate license to an applicant who meets the requirements of this title for that license.
- (B) (1) LICENSEES SHALL PRESENT AN ORIGINAL CURRENT LICENSE TO THE EMPLOYER AS PART OF THE EMPLOYMENT PROCESS.
- (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, EACH LICENSEE SHALL DISPLAY THE LICENSE CONSPICUOUSLY IN THE OFFICE OR PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT OF THE LICENSEE.
