- (I) REVERSE, [or affirm, wholly or partly, or may modify] IN WHOLE OR PART, THE ORDER, REQUIREMENT, DECISION, OR DETERMINATION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE APPEAL;
- (II) AFFIRM, IN WHOLE OR PART, THE ORDER, REQUIREMENT, DECISION, OR DETERMINATION THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE APPEAL; OR
- (III) MODIFY the order, requirement, decision, or determination [as ought to be made, and to that end] THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE APPEAL.
- (2) THE BOARD OF MUNICIPAL AND ZONING APPEALS shall have the powers of the ADMINISTRATIVE officer from whom the appeal is taken.
- [(h)](I) (1) If five members of the [Board of Zoning Appeals] BOARD OF MUNICIPAL AND ZONING APPEALS are present, the concurring vote of at least four members is necessary [to reverse] TO:
- (I) REVERSE any order, requirement, decision, or determination of an administrative [official, or to decide] OFFICER;
- (II) DECIDE in favor of the applicant on any matter on which it is required to [pass] ACT under an [ordinance; or to effect] ORDINANCE; OR
 - (III) EFFECT any variation in [the] AN ordinance.
- (2) If only four members of the [Board] BOARD are present, the concurring vote of at least three members is necessary to take any action under this subsection.
 - DRAFTER'S NOTE: In subsection (a)(2)(ii) of this section, the former language detailing the initial terms of the board of zoning appeals is deleted as obsolete.

(a) (1) [Any] AN APPEAL TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY BE FILED JOINTLY OR SEVERALLY BY ANY person [or persons], [or any] taxpayer, or [any] officer, department, board, OR bureau of the [jurisdiction, jointly or severally] CITY aggrieved: [by any] BY:
