4.02. Districts.

- (A) [For any or all of said purposes the] A local legislative body may divide the [county or municipal corporation] LOCAL JURISDICTION into districts of [such] ANY number, shape, and area [as may be deemed] THAT THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY CONSIDERS best suited to execute the purposes of this [article, and within such] ARTICLE.
- (B) (1) WITHIN THE districts [it] CREATED, THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY may regulate and restrict the erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration, [repair] REPAIR, or use of buildings, [structures] STRUCTURES, or land.
- (2) All [such] regulations shall be uniform for each class or kind of development throughout each district, but the regulations in one district may differ from those in other districts.

4.03. Purposes.

- (A) [Such] THE regulations ADOPTED BY A LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY shall be [made in] ADOPTED:
 - (1) IN accordance with the [plan] PLAN;
- (2) WITH REASONABLE CONSIDERATION FOR AMONG OTHER THINGS, THE CHARACTER OF THE DISTRICT AND ITS SUITABILITY FOR PARTICULAR USES; AND
- (3) WITH A VIEW TO CONSERVING THE VALUE OF BUILDINGS AND ENCOURAGING ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT AND THE MOST APPROPRIATE USE OF LAND.
 - (B) THE REGULATIONS SHALL BE [and] designed TO:
 - (1) [to control] CONTROL congestion in the streets;
 - (2) [to secure] SECURE the public safety;
 - (3) [to promote] PROMOTE health[,] and the general welfare;
 - (4) [to provide] PROVIDE adequate light and air;
 - (5) [to promote] PROMOTE the conservation of natural resources:
- (6) [to prevent] PREVENT environmental pollution[, to] AND avoid undue concentration of population; AND
