CONSTITUTES A FILM PRODUCTION ACTIVITY AND WHAT CONSTITUTES TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AND TAXABLE SERVICES USED DIRECTLY IN CONNECTION WITH A FILM PRODUCTION ACTIVITY.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Business and Economic Development shall conduct a study and report to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2001, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on:
- (1) the preliminary economic impact of the sales and use tax exemption created under this Act;
- (2) the potential economic impact on the State's film and video production industry of allowing a credit against the State income tax for a percentage of the wages paid for Maryland film and video productions; and
- (3) the actual impact experienced in other states in which similar income tax credits have been enacted.

SECTION  $\frac{2}{2}$ . AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

## **CHAPTER 433**

(House Bill 933)

AN ACT concerning

## Task Force on Resource Based Industry in Maryland - Establishment

FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force on Resource Based Industry in Maryland to examine the need for, and the feasibility of, establishing a certain financing development authority; requiring the Task Force to submit a certain report on or before a certain date; providing for the membership of the Task Force; requiring the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House jointly to appoint the co-chairs of the Task Force; requiring the Department of Legislative Services, in consultation with the Department of Business and Economic Development, to staff the Task Force; providing that a member of the Task Force may not be compensated but may receive travel expenses; and generally relating to establishing a Task Force on Resource Based Industry in Maryland.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) There is a Task Force on Resource Based Industry in Maryland.
- (b) The Task Force shall consist of the following members:
