

(ii) The juror shall certify under penalty of perjury that his responses are true to the best of his knowledge. Notarization is not required.

(iii) The form shall make clear to the person that furnishing any information with respect to his race, religion, or national origin is not a prerequisite to his qualifications for jury service, and that this information need not be furnished if the person finds it objectionable to do so.

8-204.

(A) Any State or local official who has custody, possession, or control of voter registration lists shall make the lists and records available to the jury commissioner or clerks for inspection and copying at any reasonable time.

(B) (1) THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE JURY COMMISSIONER OR CLERKS FOR INSPECTION AND COPYING AT ANY REASONABLE TIME:

(I) THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AND HAVE BEEN ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION; AND

(II) THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AND HAVE BEEN ISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION.

(2) THE LISTS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO THE JURY COMMISSIONER OR CLERKS WITHOUT COST.

(C) The circuit court of a county upon application by the Attorney General, may compel compliance with this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2001.

**CHAPTER 435**

**(House Bill 945)**

AN ACT concerning

**County Income Tax Disparity Grants**

FOR the purpose of altering the calculation of certain State grants to certain counties and Baltimore City based on per capita yield of county income taxes; altering certain requirements for eligibility for the grants; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to certain State grants to certain counties and Baltimore City based on per capita yield of county income taxes.
