SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments** 18-318.

- (3) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;
  - (4) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS:
- (5) ONE LICENSED PHYSICIAN WITH EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH RELEASED INMATES IN TRANSITION;
- (6) ONE REGISTERED NURSE WITH EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH RELEASED INMATES IN TRANSITION;
- (7) ONE LICENSED SOCIAL WORKER WITH EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH RELEASED INMATES IN TRANSITION:
- (8) ONE LICENSED PSYCHOLOGIST WITH EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH RELEASED INMATES IN TRANSITION;
- (9) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A COUNTY SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM;
- (10) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A BALTIMORE CITY SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM:
  - (11) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A COUNTY HEALTH CLINIC PROGRAM:
- (12) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH CLINIC PROGRAM;
- (13) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF SOCIAL SERVICES DIRECTORS:
