- (f) A public member APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (g) The Governor may remove any member for incompetence ex, misconduct, OR THE FAILURE TO ATTEND MEETINGS.

3-408:

- (a) The Governor shall appoint the Chairperson of the Board.
- $\mbox{(b)}\quad \mbox{The Chairperson may appoint subcommittees as necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the Board.}$

3-409.

- (a) In addition to any other powers granted and duties imposed by law, and subject to any restrictions imposed by law, the Board has the following powers and duties:
- (1) providing advice and counsel to the Chief in the development of the information technology master plan;
 - (2) studying existing and emerging Internet and information technology;
- (3) developing standards and making recommendations concerning Internet-based commerce, including:
 - (i) advertising on the Internet;
 - (ii) banking transactions on the Internet;
 - (iii) business transactions on the Internet:
 - (iv) taxation of Internet-based commerce; and
 - (v) taxation of Internet services;
- (4) developing standards and making recommendations concerning. Internet user privacy, including:
 - (i) the availability of personal information on the Internet;
 - (ii) the use of unsolicited bulk e-mail:
 - (iii) the use of encryption technology; and
 - (iv) the use of filters to screen out obscene or objectionable material;
- (5) making recommendations concerning Internet-based crime, including:
 - (i) on-line fraud:
 - (ii) on-line pornography; and
