~~(a) While a license, other than a limited license OR A SPECIAL DUTY LICENSE, is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide pilotage for vessels of [any] UNLIMITED draft.~~

~~(b) (1) While a 37 foot draft limited license is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide pilotage for vessels not exceeding 37 foot draft.~~

~~(2) While a 34 foot draft limited license is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide pilotage for vessels not exceeding 34 foot draft.~~

~~(3) While a 28 foot draft limited license is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide pilotage for vessels not exceeding 28 foot draft.~~

~~(C) WHILE A SPECIAL DUTY LICENSE OR A SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT CERTIFICATION IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PROVIDE PILOTAGE FOR VESSELS OF UNLIMITED DRAFT:~~
