- (II) THE SURCHARGE REPRESENTS A PAYMENT BY THE INDIVIDUAL INTO THE SPINAL CORD INJURY RESEARCH TRUST FUND: AND
- (III) THE FAILURE OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO PAY THE ADDITIONAL SURCHARGE BY THE END OF THE 15TH DAY AFTER THE DATE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S CONVICTION WILL RESULT IN ACTION BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO SUSPEND THE DRIVING PRIVILEGES OF THE INDIVIDUAL UNTIL THE SURCHARGE IS PAID.
- (3) ON RECEIPT OF A SURCHARGE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL TRANSFER THE SURCHARGE INTO THE SPINAL CORD INJURY RESEARCH TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 13-1006 OF THE HEALTH—CENERAL ARTICLE.
- (4) IF AN INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO PAY THE SURCHARGE WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S CONVICTION, THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL ORDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO INITIATE AN ACTION, UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS, TO SUSPEND THE DRIVING PRIVILEGES OF THE INDIVIDUAL UNTIL THE INDIVIDUAL PAYS THE SURCHARGE.
