- (A) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT A FULL TIME DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE.
 - (2) THE DIRECTOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SECRETARY.
 - (B) THE DIRECTOR IS ENTITLED TO:
 - (1) COMPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET: AND
- (2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL RECULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
 - (C) THE DIRECTOR SHALL:
 - (1) ADMINISTER AND OPERATE THE OFFICE; AND
 - (2) BE RESPONSIBLE TO THE SECRETARY.
- (D) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE ETHICS LAW, THE DIRECTOR MAY NOT:
- (1) HOLD ANY POSITION OR ENCAGE IN ANY BUSINESS THAT INTERFERES OR CONFLICTS WITH THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR:
 - (2) BE A RECISTRANT;
- (3) ENCAGE IN ANY ACT FOR WHICH A REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE: OR
- (4) IN CONNECTION WITH ANY REGISTRANT, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY RECEIVE OR BECOME ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ANY FEE, PERQUISITE, OR COMPENSATION.
