Secretary's designee, that a pending charge for a crime which has not been finally adjudicated shall be conclusive evidence of the pending charge.

- (vi) Failure of the applicant or a licensee to appear at the scheduled hearing shall be considered grounds for dismissal of the contest.
- (6) (I) INSTEAD OF IN ADDITION TO A STATE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, AND SUBJECT TO ARTICLE 27, §§ 742 THROUGH 755 OF THE CODE, THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE AN APPLICANT TO OBTAIN A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK FROM THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.
- (II) AN APPLICANT WHO IS REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSION TO OBTAIN A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK FROM THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL:
- 1. APPLY TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK;
- 2. SUBMIT TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY ONE COMPLETE SET OF THE APPLICANT'S LEGIBLE FINGERPRINTS TAKEN ON FORMS APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION; AND
- 3. SUBMIT TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY THE MANDATORY PROCESSING FEE REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK.
- (7) The Commission may use a private agency to provide a background check on an applicant or licensee under this section, as determined by the Commission.
- (c) (1) After the initial printed statement has been received from the Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository, the Commission shall issue a passenger-for-hire driver's license or a taxicab driver's license, as appropriate, to each applicant that meets the requirements of this title.
- (2) The passenger-for-hire driver's license and the taxicab driver's license shall be in the form that the Commission provides.
 - (D) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.
- (2) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2002, AN INDIVIDUAL APPLYING FOR A TAXICAB LICENSE OR RENEWAL OF A TAXICAB LICENSE, SHALL SUBMIT PROOF OF HAVING SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A COURSE APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION THAT INCLUDES IN THE CURRICULUM:
 - (I) COURTEOUS TREATMENT OF PASSENGERS;
