- (2) Recommend the appointment by the Board of employees necessary for the efficient administration of the Center;
- (3) Recommend the discharge of employees for good cause and in accordance with applicable laws and policies;
- (4) Be responsible to the Board for the conduct of the Center and for its administration and supervision;
- (5) Attend all meetings of the Board, except those involving the Director's personal position; [and]
  - (6) SUBJECT TO THE POLICIES AND GUIDELINES OF THE COMMISSION:
    - (I) DEVELOP A MISSION STATEMENT;
- $\,$  (II) SUBMIT THE MISSION STATEMENT TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE CENTER; AND
- (III) UPON THE DIRECTION OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS, UPDATE THE MISSION STATEMENT EVERY 4 YEARS; AND
  - [(6)](7) Perform other duties as assigned by the Board.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

## CHAPTER 543

## (Senate Bill 604)

AN ACT concerning

## Creation of a State Debt - Charles County - Port Tobacco Players Theater

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$800,000 \$400,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Port Tobacco Players, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the <u>Charles County -</u> Port Tobacco Players Theater Loan of 2000 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$400,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
