(2) COMPLETE A NATURAL CAS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM THAT IS OFFERED BY A THIRD PARTY AND IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

An applicant for a license shall:

- (1) submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and
- (2) except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, pay to the Board or the Board's designee an examination fee:
- (i) for a master plumber license or, a journey plumber license, <u>OR A MASTER NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE</u>, in an amount set by the Board, not to exceed the cost of the required examination;
- (ii) for an apprentice plumber license <u>OR APPRENTICE NATURAL</u> GAS FITTERS LICENSE of \$15; [or]
  - (iii) for a propane gas fitter certificate of \$25; OR
- (IV) FOR A MASTER NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE OR A JOURNEYMAN NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE, IN AN AMOUNT SET BE THE BOARD, NOT TO EXCEED THE COST OF THE REQUIRED EXAMINATION.
- (IV) FOR A JOURNEYMAN NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE OF \$25; OR
- (V) FOR A MASTER NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE WITHOUT EXAMINATION OF \$50.

*12–304*.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in § 12-304.1 of this subtitle, an applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.
- (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Board shall give examinations to qualified applicants at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (2) The Board shall give an examination at least once a year in Baltimore City.
- (c) The Board shall give each qualified applicant notice of the time and place of examination.
- (d) (1) The Board shall determine the subjects, scope, and form of and the passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.
