- (7) the Secretary of Higher Education or the Secretary's designee;
- (8) the Special Secretary for the Office of Children, Youth, and Families in the Governor's Office or the Special Secretary's designee;
- (9) the Secretary of Business and Economic Development or the Secretary's designee;
- (10) the Secretary of Housing and Community Development or the Secretary's designee; and
 - (11) the following members appointed by the Governor:
- (i) one representative of the Maryland Child Care Resource Network;
 - (ii) one representative of the University System of Maryland;
 - (iii) one representative of community colleges in the State:
 - (iv) two representatives of the Maryland business community;
 - (v) one representative of the banking industry in the State;
 - (vi) one representative of family child care providers in the State;
 - (vii) one representative of child care centers in the State;
 - (viii) two parents of children in child care programs in the State;
 - (ix) one representative of a child advocacy group; and
- (x) one economist who is familiar with innovative funding strategies.
- (f) (1) A member appointed by the Governor shall be appointed on or before July 1, 2000.
 - (2) A member shall serve until the end of December 31, 2001.
- (g) The chairman of the Commission shall be appointed jointly by the Governor, the President, and the Speaker on or before July 1, 2000.
- (h) (1) The first meeting of the Commission shall be held on or before September 1, 2000.
- (2) The Commission shall hold subsequent meetings at times and locations determined by the Commission.
 - (i) A member of the Commission:
 - (1) may not receive compensation; but
- (2) shall receive compensation for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations as provided in the State budget.
