 - (b) Each recipient of a Maryland HOPE Scholarship shall:
- (1) Be accepted for admission in a regular undergraduate program at an eligible institution in the State;
 - (2) Be a resident of the State;
- (3) Earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent in core curriculum courses as calculated and indicated on the high school transcript after the first semester of the senior year [from a] OF high school [in this State];

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act that allow a recipient of a Maryland HOPE Scholarship or a Maryland teacher scholarship to hold multiple grants, scholarships, or awards under Title 18 of the Education Article shall be applied retroactively to any recipient of the Maryland HOPE Scholarship or the Maryland teacher scholarship who was awarded that scholarship prior to the effective date of this Act.
