- (4) Paying insurance costs by the State to extend or implement the benefits of the Fund.
- (h) The Department shall provide the standing committees of the Maryland General Assembly with primary jurisdiction over this section with a status report on the Fund on or before October 1 of each year. The report shall include an accounting of all moneys expended for each of the purposes specified in subsection (g) of this section.

## 4-704.

- (a) There is an Oil Contaminated Site Environmental Cleanup Fund.
- (b) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE Fund shall be used to:
  - (1) Reimburse an owner or operator of:
- (I) [an] AN underground oil storage tank SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 4-409(B)(3) OF THIS TITLE for site rehabilitation costs incurred on or after October 1, 1993 resulting from contamination caused by releases from an underground oil storage tank;
- (II) AN UNDERGROUND OIL STORAGE TANK NOT SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 4–409(B)(3) OF THIS TITLE FOR SITE REHABILITATION COSTS INCURRED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2000 RESULTING FROM CONTAMINATION CAUSED BY RELEASES FROM AN UNDERGROUND OIL STORAGE TANK; OR
- (III) A HEATING OIL TANK FOR SITE REHABILITATION COSTS INCURRED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2000 RESULTING FROM CONTAMINATION CAUSED BY RELEASES FROM A HEATING OIL TANK INCLUDING PIPING CONNECTED TO THE TANK;
- (2) Provide funds for site rehabilitation activities carried out by the Department or under the Department's direction and control; and
- (3) To the extent provided in the State budget and in an amount not to exceed [3%] 8% of the revenues in the Fund during the fiscal year, provide funds for the Department's administration of this subtitle.
- (c) TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE REVENUES CREDITED TO THE FUND SHALL BE USED FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF HEATING OIL TANK SITE REHABILITATION COSTS AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE.
  - (D) The provisions of this subtitle do not apply to:
    - (1) [an] AN underground storage tank that is:
    - [(1) Exempt from the requirements of § 4-409(b)(3) of this title;
    - (2)] (I) Owned by a state, county, or municipal corporation; or
    - [(3)] (II) Owned by a local education agency.
