 - (1) COMPLIES WITH § 12–108 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
 - (2) OTHERWISE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- (A) A LICENSE EXPIRES ON DECEMBER 31 IN EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR UNLESS IT IS RENEWED FOR A 2-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- (B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF THE YEAR OF EXPIRATION, A LICENSE MAY BE RENEWED FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE:
 - (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED:
 - (2) PAYS TO THE COMMISSIONER A RENEWAL FEE OF \$1,000; AND
- (3) SUBMITS TO THE COMMISSIONER A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSIONER REQUIRES; AND
- (4) IF A SURETY BOND HAD BEEN FILED INITIALLY, FILES A SURETY BOND OR SURETY BOND CONTINUATION CERTIFICATE FOR THE AMOUNT REQUIRED UNDER § 12-108 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (C) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DETERMINE IF THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 12–106 OF THIS SUBTITLE TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE CONTINUE TO APPLY.
- (D) THE COMMISSIONER MAY DETERMINE THAT LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL EXPIRE ON A STAGGERED BASIS.

 - (A) A LICENSE IS NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- (B) A LICENSEE SHALL DISPLAY THE LICENSE CONSPICUOUSLY AT THE LICENSEE'S PLACE OF BUSINESS OR MOBILE UNIT.

 12–113.
- (A) A LICENSEE MAY NOT CHANGE THE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR WHICH A LICENSE IS ISSUED UNLESS THE LICENSEE:
- $\hspace{0.1in}$ (1) NOTIFIES THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING OF THE PROPOSED CHANGE; AND
- (2) RECEIVES THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE COMMISSIONER PRIOR TO THE CHANGE.
- (B) IF THE COMMISSIONER CONSENTS TO A PROPOSED CHANGE OF PLACE OF BUSINESS, THE LICENSEE SHALL ATTACH THE WRITTEN CONSENT TO THE LICENSE.
