(IX) ONE MEMBER REPRESENTING FORESTRY GROUPS IN THE STATE; AND

(X) ONE MEMBER FROM THE MARYLAND LAND TRUST ALLIANCE.

~~(D)~~ (E) A MEMBER OF THE TASK FORCE MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR SERVING ON THE TASK FORCE, BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

~~(E)~~ (F) THE TASK FORCE SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIRMAN.
