- (I) THE QUALITY OF BOTH ARTS AND SCIENCES PROGRAMS; AND
- (II) THE DECREE TO WHICH THE MEMBERS OF THE ARTS AND SCIENCES AND EDUCATION FACULTY TEACHING TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS SERVE AS EQUAL PARTNERS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THOSE PROGRAMS.
- (B) (1) WORKING WITH THE COVERNING BOARDS AND WITH THE DEPARTMENT; THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT CRITERIA, ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2001; FOR MEASURING THE QUALITY OF TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS
 - (2) THE CRITERIA ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
- (I) PASS RATES FOR ALL STUDENTS WHO TAKE THE TEACHER CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION REQUIRED BY THE STATE, REPORTED BY RACE, ETHNICITY, AND FAMILY INCOME:
- (II) THE COURSE WORK THAT STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE IN:
 - 1. THE EDUCATION CURRICULUM: AND
 - 2. CONTENT AREAS OTHER THAN EDUCATION; AND
 - (HI) ACCREDITATION BY NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS.

- (A) USING THE ANNUAL REPORT REQUIRED UNDER § 11-306.1 OF THIS TITLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL ANNUALLY EVALUATE THE QUALITY OF TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS OFFERED BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE.
- (B) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2002 AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE COMMISSION -SHALL RECOMMEND TO THE COVERNING BOARDS THAT ANY INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT DOES NOT OFFER A HIGH QUALITY TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM, AS EVIDENCED BY THE CRITERIA ADOPTED UNDER § 11 306.1(B) OF THIS TITLE, BE REQUIRED TO DISCONTINUE THAT PROGRAM.
