- (4) § 21-902(d) of this article of driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle while under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance.
- [(d)](E) When a suspension imposed under subsections (b) and (c) of this section expires, the Administration immediately shall return the license or reinstate the privilege of the driver, unless the license or privilege has been refused, revoked, suspended, or canceled under any other provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.
