Joint Resolution No. 7

(Senate Joint Resolution No. 11)

A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

Postsecondary Secondary Career and Technology Education Programs

FOR the purpose of stating the intent of the General Assembly to concur in placing certain postsecondary secondary career and technology education programs in the Maryland Unified Plan for Workforce Investment.

WHEREAS, Maryland has collaboratively developed a Unified Plan for Workforce Investment to be submitted in April 2000 to the appropriate federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, The federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998 represents the achievement of consensus on the need to restructure a multiplicity of workforce development programs into an integrated workforce investment system that can better respond to the employment needs of the business community in Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Maryland's current workforce demands exceed the number of qualified workers available for employment; and
