In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 19 – Motor Vehicle Administration – Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program – Extension.

This bill extends the Chesapeake Bay commemorative license plate program to July 1, 2002.

House Bill 169, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 11, 2000, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 19.

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicle Administration – Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program – Extension

FOR the purpose of extending the termination date of the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program until a certain date; and generally relating to the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program.
