

(g) (1) After 30 days from the date a notice is sent under subsection (f) of this section, a motor carrier that has had its operator's registration or operating privileges revoked under this section may not operate a commercial motor vehicle in this State.

(2) Each operation of a vehicle in violation of this subsection is a separate offense and is punishable under the Road Tax on Motor Carriers Act.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

CHAPTER 28

(Senate Bill 47)

Maryland Advisory Council for Individuals with Disabilities - Membership

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-1107.

(a) (1) The Council consists of [28] 30 members appointed by the Governor.

(2) Of the [28] 30 members, 15 of the members shall be individuals with disabilities.

(b) Of the [28] 30 Council members:

(1) 1 shall be a member of the State Senate;

(2) 1 shall be a member of the House of Delegates;

(3) 1 shall be the Secretary or a designee from the Department of Budget and Management;
