FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS OR INFORMATION, MEDICAL INFORMATION, RESTRICTED PERSONAL INFORMATION, OR ANY OTHER TANCIBLE OR INTANGIBLE ITEM OF VALUE.

- (13) "SERVICES" INCLUDES COMPUTER TIME, DATA PROCESSING, STORAGE FUNCTIONS, COMPUTER MEMORY, OR THE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF A COMPUTER PROGRAM, COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK, OR COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK.
- (b) This section does not preclude the applicability of any other provision of this Code.
- (c) (1) A person may not intentionally, willfully, and without authorization access, attempt to access, cause access, or exceed the person's authorized access, to a computer, computer network, computer software, computer control language, computer system, computer services, computer data base, or any part of these systems or services.
- (2) A person may not intentionally, willfully, and without authorization access, attempt to access, cause access, or exceed the person's authorized access, to a computer, computer network, computer software, computer control language, computer system, computer services, computer data base, or any part of these systems or services to:
- (i) Cause the malfunction or interrupt the operation of a computer, computer network, computer software, computer control language, computer system, computer services, computer data base, or any part of these systems or services; or
- (ii) Alter, damage, or destroy data or a computer program stored, maintained, or produced by a computer, computer network, computer system, computer services, computer data base, or any part of these systems or services.
 - (3) A person may not intentionally, willfully, and without authorization:
- (i) Possess, identify, or attempt to identify any valid access codes; or
- (ii) Distribute or publicize any valid access codes to any unauthorized person.
- (d) (1) Any person who violates any provision of subsection (c)(1) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or both.
- (2) (I) Any person who violates any provision of subsection (c)(2) or (c)(3) of this section WHERE THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF THE LOSS IS LESS THAN \$5,000 \$10,000 is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or both.
- (II) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (C)(2) OR (C)(3) OF THIS SECTION WHERE THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF THE LOSS IS
