- (ii) Transport from the scene of a medical emergency to a hospital or appropriate facility whether or not medical services are provided;
- (iii) Medical interfacility transport services to an appropriate facility; or
- (iv) Medical interfacility critical care transport to an appropriate facility.
- (6) "Emergency medical services provider" means an individual licensed or certified by the EMS Board as:
 - (i) A cardiac rescue technician;
 - (ii) An emergency medical dispatcher;
 - (iii) An emergency medical technician-ambulance;
 - (iv) An emergency medical technician-basic;
 - (v) An emergency medical technician-paramedic; or
 - (vi) A first responder.
- (7) "Emergency medical technician-ambulance" (EMT-A) means an individual who has:
- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician-ambulance course approved by the EMS Board;
- (ii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols as determined by the EMS Board; and
- (iii) Been examined by the EMS Board and certified as an EMT-A by the EMS Board.
- $\hbox{$(8)$ $``Emergency medical technician-basic" (EMT-B) means an individual who has:}$
- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician-basic course approved by the EMS Board;
- (ii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols as determined by the EMS Board; and
- $\mbox{(iii)}\;\;$ Been examined by the EMS Board and certified as an EMT-B by the EMS Board.
- (9) "Emergency medical technician-paramedic" (EMT-P) means an individual who has:
- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician-paramedic course approved by the EMS Board;
