AN ACT concerning

Maryland Veterans Commission – Membership

FOR the purpose of adding a representative from the Maryland Coalition of the Retired Enlisted Association to the Maryland Veterans Commission; and generally relating to the Maryland Veterans Commission.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – State Government
Section 9–907
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1999 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

9–907.

(a) (1) The Commission consists of the following [28] 29 members:

(i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission; and

(ii) [27] 28 members appointed by the Governor.
