education to receive a certain vaccination or sign a certain waiver; <u>requiring the parent or guardian of the student to sign the waiver if the student is a minor;</u> requiring the Secretary of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in consultation with the Maryland Higher Education Commission, to adopt certain regulations; providing that certain institutions of higher education are not required to provide or pay for vaccinations for meningococcal disease; requiring the Commission to assist in implementing certain requirements; and generally relating to vaccination against infectious and contagious diseases.
