AN ACT concerning

Nursing Homes - Quality of Care Oversight

FOR the purpose of establishing an Oversight Committee on Quality of Care in Nursing Homes; specifying the membership of the Oversight Committee; specifying the duties of the Oversight Committee; requiring the Office of Health Care Quality of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to report to the Oversight Committee twice annually; requiring the Department's Deputy Secretary of Health Care Financing to report to the Oversight Committee annually; requiring the Oversight Committee to make certain recommendations and to take into account and examine certain issues; requiring the Secretary of the Department of Aging to chair the Oversight Committee; requiring the Department of Aging to provide staff support for the Oversight Committee; requiring the Oversight Committee to submit a certain report to the Governor and General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of the Oversight Committee; and generally relating to the Oversight Committee on Quality of Care in Nursing Homes.
