- (3) The Director is responsible for establishing policy to be followed by the units in the Office.
 - (4) The Director is a member of the Governor's Executive Council.
- (e) The Director is entitled to the salary provided in the State budget.5-201.
- (A) THERE IS A DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING, ESTABLISHED AS A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.
- (B) THE HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT IS THE SECRETARY OF PLANNING, WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
- (C) THE SECRETARY SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR AND IS RESPONSIBLE DIRECTLY TO THE GOVERNOR
- (D) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADVISE THE GOVERNOR ON ALL MATTERS ASSIGNED TO THE DEPARTMENT AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CARRYING OUT THE GOVERNOR'S POLICIES ON THESE MATTERS.
- (2) THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL ESTABLISH GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES TO PROMOTE THE ORDERLY AND EFFICIENT OPERATION OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- (3) THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH, REORGANIZE, OR ABOLISH AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY IN THE DEPARTMENT AS NECESSARY TO FULFILL THE DUTIES ASSIGNED TO THE SECRETARY.
- (E) THE SECRETARY IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

- (a) The [Director] SECRETARY may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget.
- (b) Each staff assistant in charge of a particular area of responsibility and each professional consultant is in the executive service, management service, or is a special appointment in the State Personnel Management System and is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the [Director] SECRETARY.
- (c) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section or otherwise by law, the [Director] SECRETARY shall appoint and remove all other staff in accordance with the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
- (d) The [Director] SECRETARY may review any personnel action taken by any unit in the [Office] DEPARTMENT.
